# **Deed of Grant**

Once your application has been considered, a Deed of the Grant of Exclusive Right of Burial will be sent to you. The Deed is for a period of fifty years.

(Details of how long it can be extended by, and time limit is currently not allowed, but is under consideration).

#### General

Please refer to the Rules and Regulations of the Cemetery/Burial Ground regarding the selection of memorials, the workmanship of memorial masons and the maintenance of the plots.

# For your guidance the following restrictions apply:

All memorial stones must have a minimum thickness of 3" (0.08m).

# **Provision of Memorials**

# **Lawn Cremation Plots and Cremation Plots**

You may place out on the cremation plot (depending on type of grave purchased and cemetery) a memorial made of natural stone to a dimension according to the rules and regulations in force at the time of application. The application for a memorial will be provided on request which details the dimensions currently in force.

## Maintenance

In the Cremation Section the Council aims to provide a dignified setting, free from any fencing of vases, Jars or planting around the memorial stones. The area will be maintained as lawns by the Cemetery staff who have been instructed to remove any unauthorised stones, plants, fences or any other borders so that we can keep the area well maintained for the benefit of all visitors to the Cemetery.

A permit must be obtained from the Council prior to a memorial being fixed, and as mentioned above, a fee will be payable.

If you have any questions or if there is anything that you need explained in more detail, do not hesitate to contact the Cemetery Section of the Council who will be pleased to help.
