If you are granted a discount, you may have to reapply every year. You must tell us immediately about any change in your circumstances, such as a child in the household reaching 18, or another adult moving into the household.

Discounts where adults living at the property are disregarded

If certain adults are 'disregarded' for Council Tax purposes, it may mean that they are entitled to a discount. Disregarded adults fall into one of the following groups. Proof we need:

Person in prison (or any other place of detention) - We will send you a separate form.

Severely mentally disabled

Where Child Benefit is being paid

Student

Apprentice

Youth Training Scheme

Hospital patient

Patient in a care home

Person who provides care

Person living in a hostel

School leaver

Member of a religious community

Diplomat

- Doctor's certificate and confirmation of appropriate allowances.
- A copy of the first page of the payment book.
- An up-to-date certificate from the college or university.
- A copy of the agreement between the apprentice and the employer.
- A copy of the letter confirming your entry to the scheme.
- A letter from the hospital.
- A letter from the care home, relative or doctor.
- A letter from the doctor. You can get a separate application form for this situation.
- A letter from the hostel.
- None as long as you were previously entitled to a student
- A letter from the religious community.
- A copy of the diplomatic passport.

You can claim a discount if you or the other adults living in your home fall into one or more of the above groups, but there must not be more than one person living in your home (including you) who is not disregarded.

You can also get this form in large print.
