Tim's Tips - Keeping your clubs in order

This time of year, it is all too easy to leave your clubs in the car until the next game, but not cleaning your clubs could be having an adverse effect on your game!

- Cleaning the grooves on your irons will help you make better contact, and will help you get more spin when striking the ball
- Washing your grips in warm soapy water with a hard brush will help you remove accumulations of grease and grime, making them easier to hold
- Roughen up the clubface by giving it a light sanding
- Graphite shafts can be protected from scuffing by wrapping insulation tape around the last 4 inches
- If your grips are damaged, consider getting them re-gripped. Ask at the clubhouse, re-gripping can cost as little as £4 per club
