

## **BROADWATER VILLAGE SIGN**

### CONSULTATION COMMENTS

#### Opulence and Grace

All positive comments, customers and staff supportive of the sign, suggest not too many colours, keeping colours plain (black) so it will not age. Would have liked the sign nearer to the mini-roundabout and the entrance to the shops.

#### Post Office

Lots of customers pleased with the idea of the new sign

#### Findon Framing

Supportive of the idea of having a sign, but not too keen on the design. Did not like the cricket ball as it looked like a shooting star. Not clear that the sign would be hand made from wrought iron, but liked this. Be careful of the sharp points as these may be used to hang items from when the pubs close (ie: pizzas, coats and cardboard etc). Would prefer the sign mounted rather than 3D and moulded/stencil. Think the letters should be gold or white to stand out.

#### Martins Newsagents

Staff are supportive of the sign and would welcome a new poster to display of the final design, including colour.

#### Barclays Bank

Not many comments received, although staff are supportive of the sign. Like the planned position of the sign.

#### Cancer Care

Staff and customers supportive of sign and have passed their sheet over to the chemist for display to their customers.

#### Link Romania

Staff really like the sign including the design. Keen for the colours to remain simple, liked the idea of the red for the cricket ball, and the green for the grass. Thought the lettering should remain black with the rectangle border coloured to make the 'BROADWATER VILLAGE' stand out. Likes the planned position of the sign.
