1. Although all expressions of interest submitted will be considered by the Council, the Council does not undertake to proceed further with any enquiry.
2. In assessing whether to proceed further with any expression of interest, the Council will have regard to the nature of the operation proposed, the specified location, and any other relevant factors.
3. The Council will acknowledge receipt of all expressions of interest submitted and, where it decides to proceed further with a particular expression of interest, it will contact the applicant concerned direct.
4. Approved concessions will initially be granted for a trial period only and be subject to all necessary consents being obtained by the applicant and to terms and conditions to be specified by the Council. Operators of approved concessions will be required to provide the following before the concession is finalised:
 - Appropriate Public Liability Insurance cover
 - Satisfactory CRB check
 - Satisfactory Bank and other References
 - Satisfactory Risk Assessment
5. While there is no deadline for submission of any expressions of interest, prospective operators are asked to ensure that the forms are returned to the Council as quickly as possible if they wish their proposals to be considered in time for the 2009 summer season.
